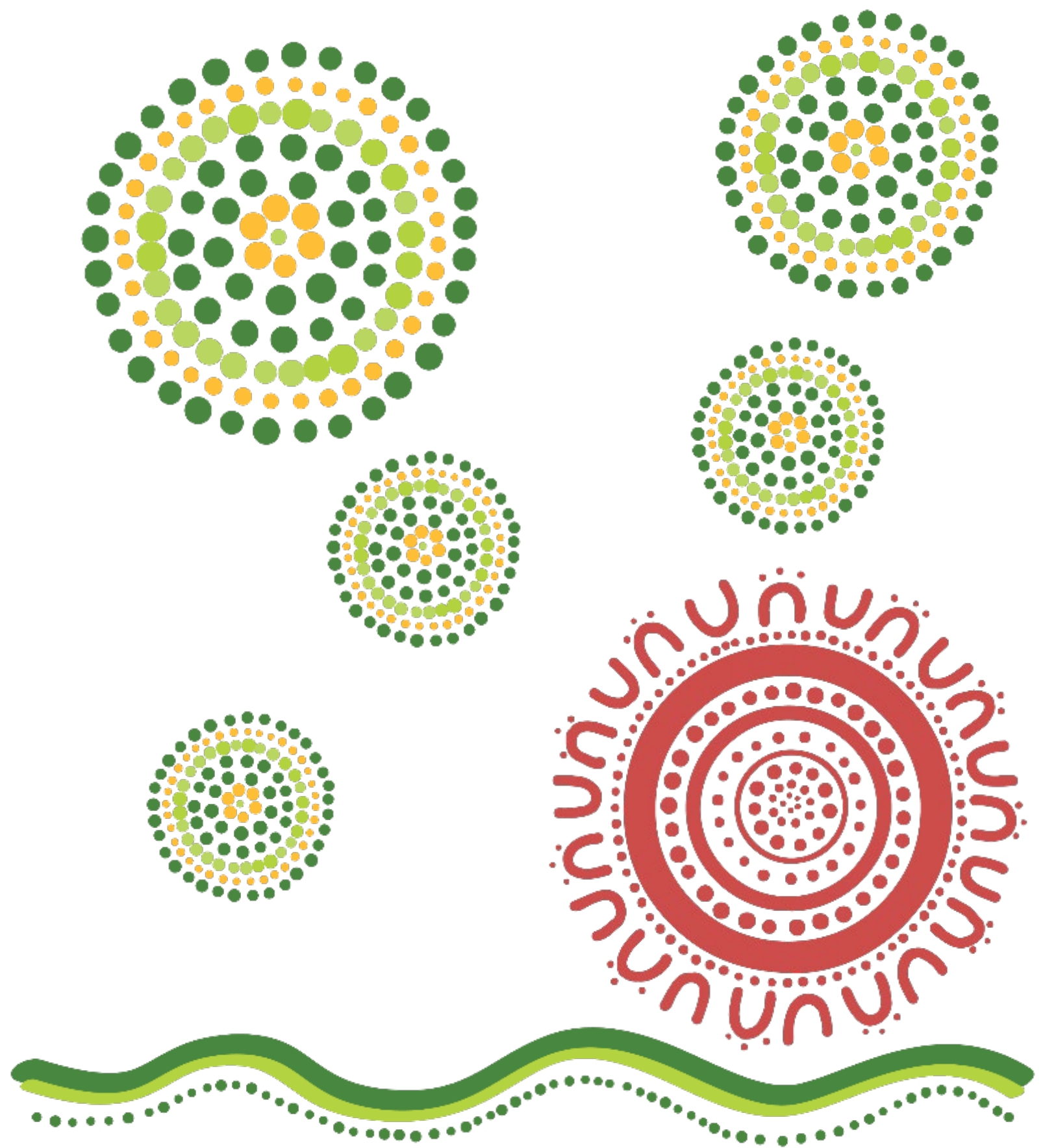

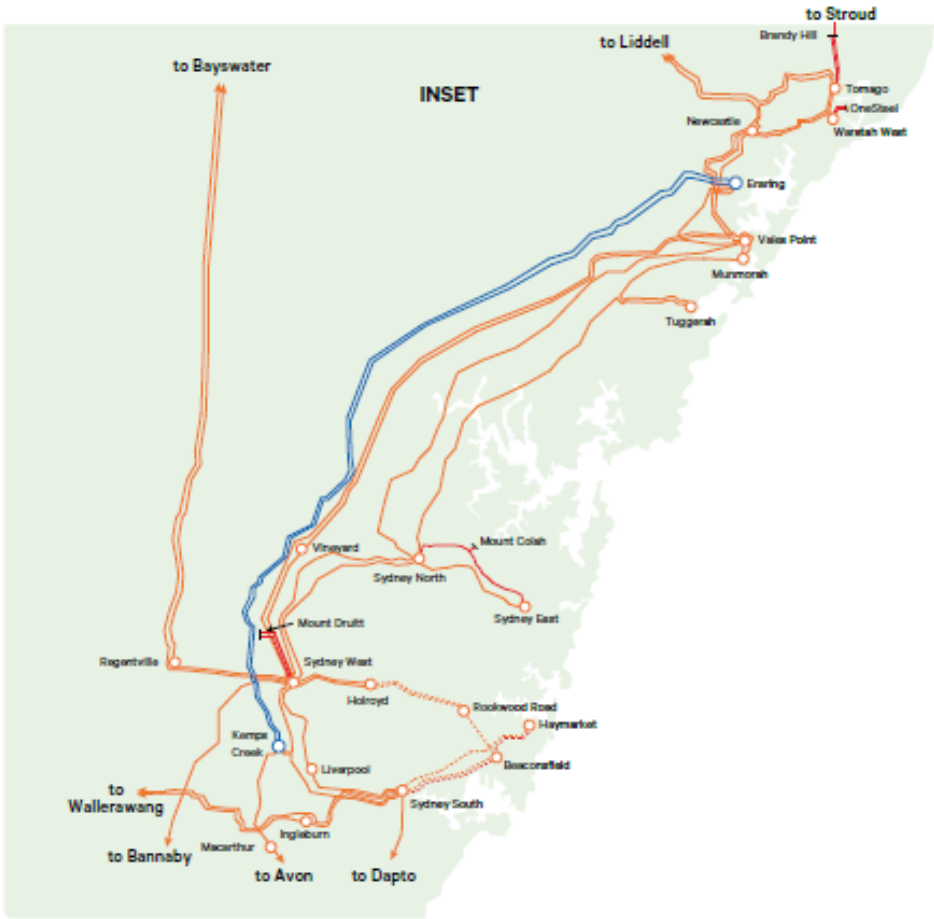


About Transgrid

Transgrid's network delivers a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply to over 3.7 million households and businesses across NSW and the ACT.

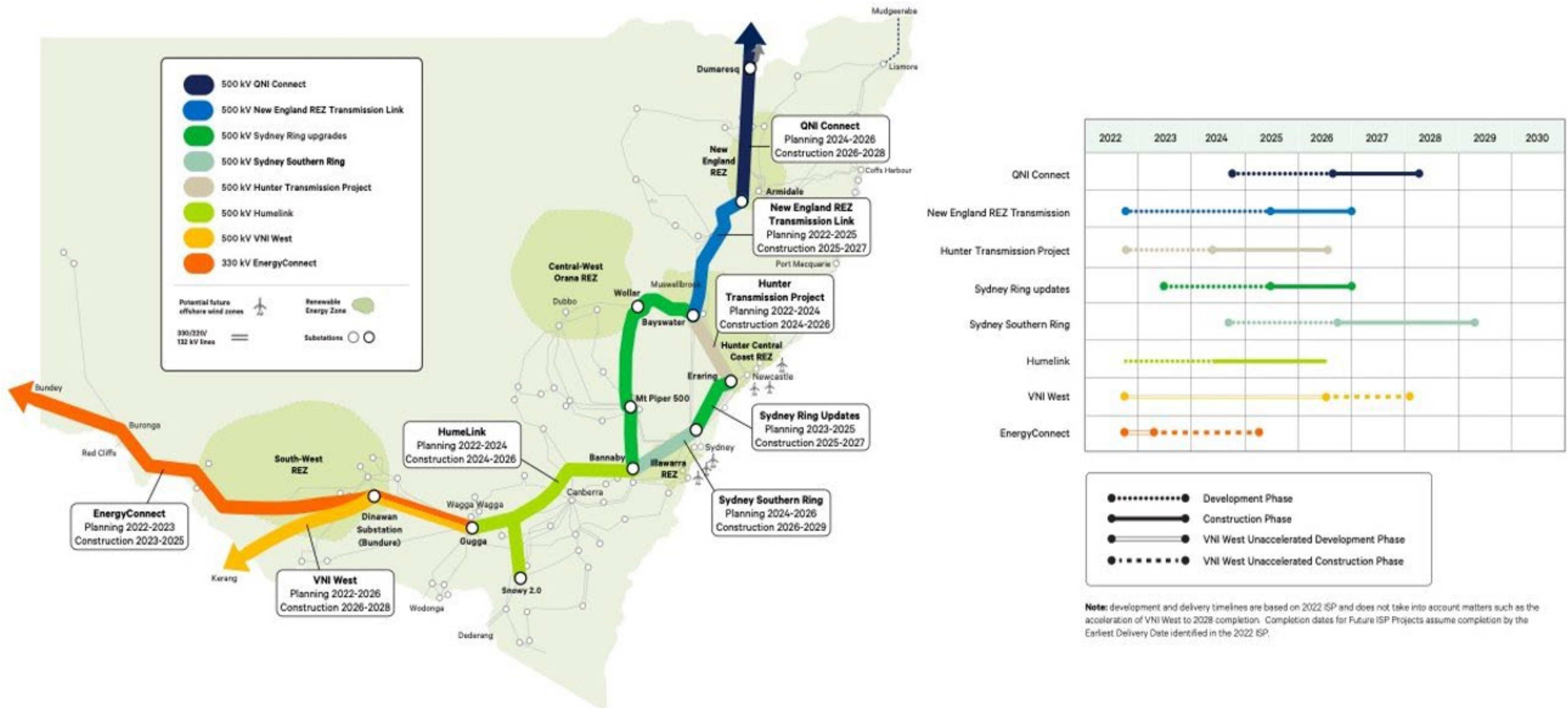
- 121 substations

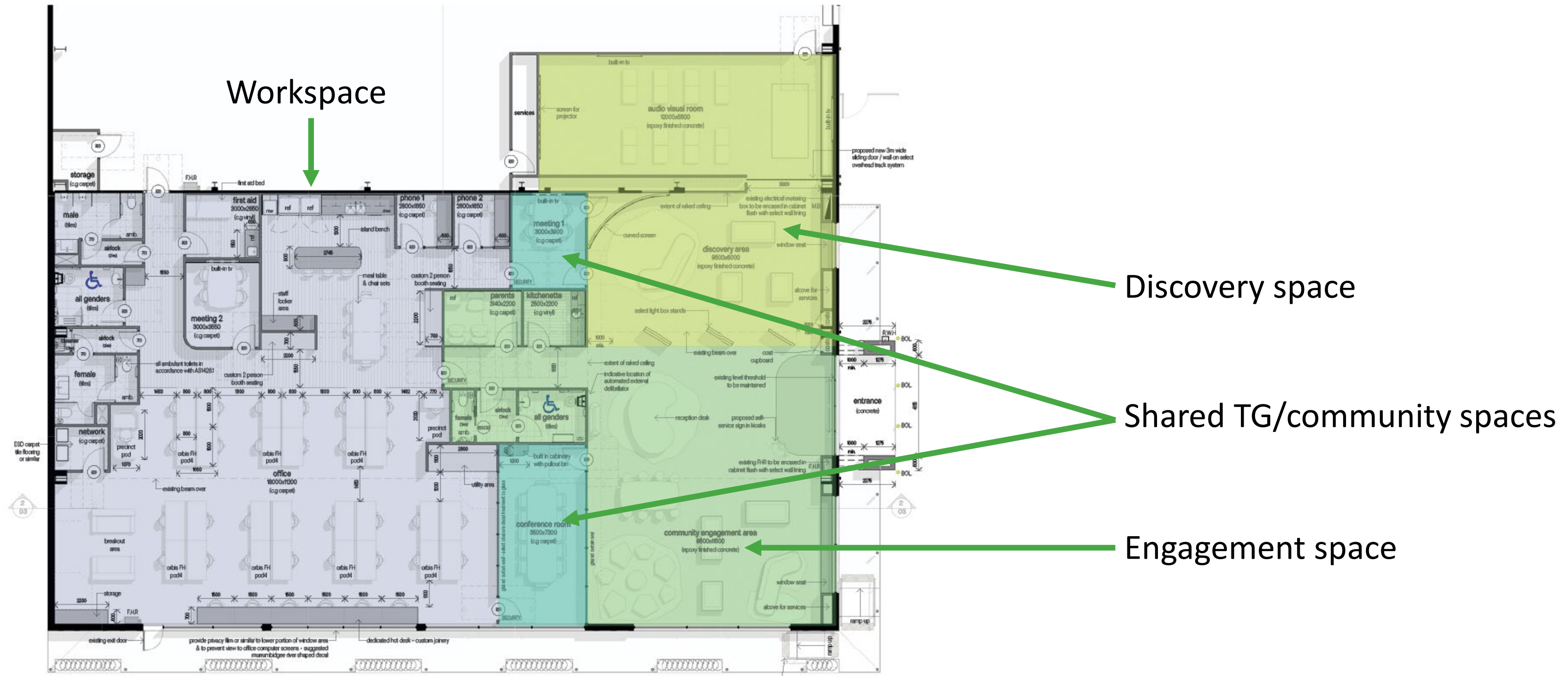

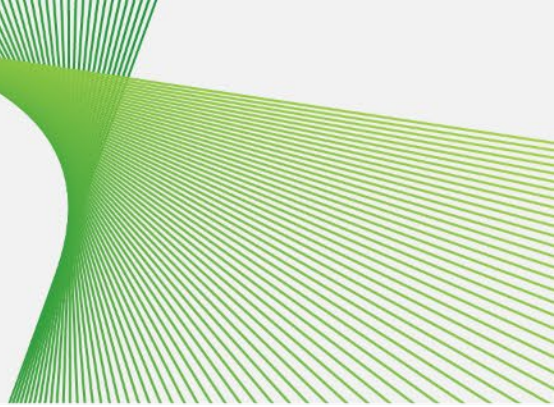

Transgrid's focus for the Riverina



1. Jobs & Skills – Transgrid’s aim is to drive workforce development and economic growth initiatives for the Riverina as part of Transgrid’s EnergyConnect, HumeLink and VNI West projects.



2. Local and First Nations Industry Development - Supporting the participation and development of Aboriginal and Local businesses to drive local economic benefits into our projects with a First Nations participation target of 2.5%-5% and local participation target of 10%-15% across our Major Projects.



3. Community Investment – Through community and stakeholder engagement we identify the social impacted themes for the communities we impact. We develop Community Investment Plans for each Major Project to hold ourselves accountable to deliver investment back into communities we impact. HumeLink as an example will provide investment into communities along the themes of: Workforce accommodation repurposing, Community Connectivity, Caring for Country, Local jobs, skills and procurement

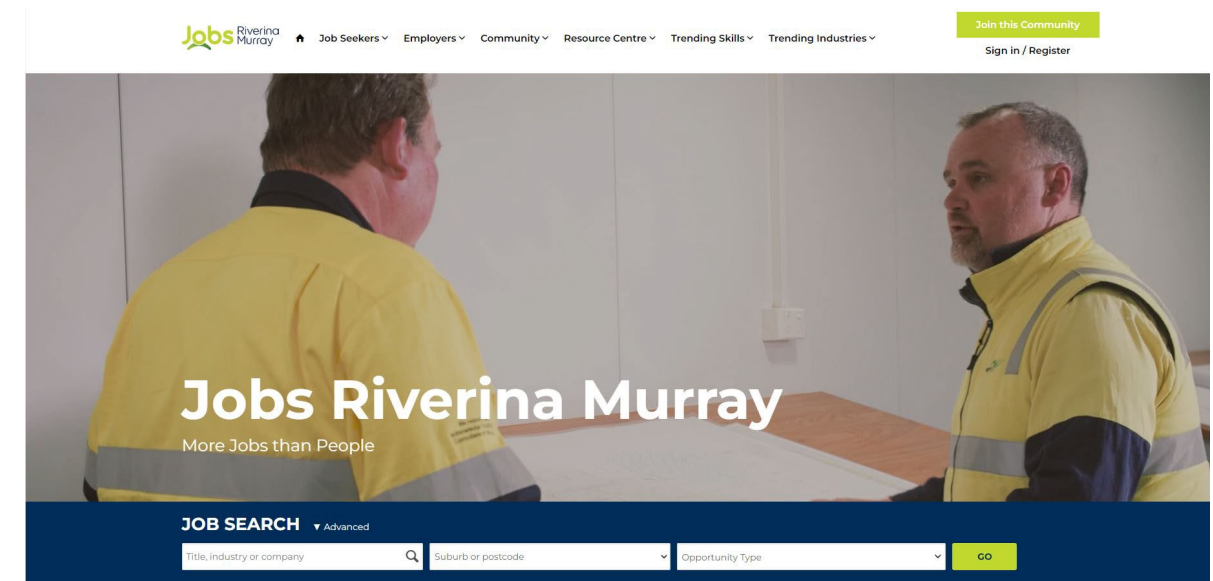
