The Australian Government announced the new Building Better Regions Fund (BBRF) to replace the National Stronger Regions Fund (NSRF) in July. The BBRF will support infrastructure and community initiatives in areas outside of major cities.

The new fund will assess projects in three categories depending on the size of the project. This will mean applications for smaller grants will not be competing with large projects for funding.

# **Flooding Assistance**

**Natural Disaster Relief Scheme** 

The Natural Disaster Relief Scheme assists communities and individuals directly affected by flood, fire, storm damage or any other declared natural disaster.

To support relief and recovery following a declared Natural Disaster a range of measures are made available by the NSW Government. These measures include low interest rate <u>loans</u> to primary producers, small businesses, non-profit organisations and sporting clubs and <u>transport assistance</u> for primary producers.

Additional assistance in the form of <u>Recovery Grants</u> may also be made available following extreme and widespread disaster events.

To report damage following a severe weather event Primary Producers are encouraged to contact their closest Local Land Services (LLS) office or telephone on 1300 795 299.
