The Riverina successful events of Round One of the 2017 Incubator Event Fund are:

The <u>Incubator Event Fund</u> is one of three funding opportunities under the umbrella title of the <u>Regional Flagship Events Program</u>.

Jobs for NSW is supporting regional businesses expand and create jobs through a dedicated suite of products. Regional businesses may apply for any of the grants and support services provided by Jobs for NSW subject to the eligibility requirements of each product. In December 2016 Gundagai Meat Processors (GMP) were successful in their application for a \$4 million loan guarantee from the "Jobs for NSW" program to upgrade its operations, creating an additional 76 full-time jobs in the next five years. GMP has operated as a lamb processor for more than 40 years and is the largest employer in Gundagai.
