

Abolition and Replacement of the 457 Visa - Government Reforms to Employer Sponsered Skilled Migration Visas

On 18 April 2017, the Government announced that the Temporary Work (Skilled) visa (subclass 457 visa) will be abolished and replaced with the completely new Temporary Skill Shortage (TSS) visa in March 2018.

The TSS visa programme will be comprised of a Short-Term stream of up to **two years** and a Medium-Term stream of up to **four years** and will support businesses in addressing genuine skill

shortages in their workforce and will contain a number of safeguards which prioritise Australian workers.

This new visa is part of the Government's significant reform package to strengthen the integrity and quality of Australia's temporary and permanent employer sponsored skilled migration programmes.

# **Riverina Skills in Demand List Updated**

The Regional Development Australia Riverina is a Regional Certifying Body (RCB) for the Department of Immigration & Border Protection (DIBP).

We provide assessment and sponsorship to 2 visa categories being the individual Skilled - Regional (Provisional) Sponsored Visa subclass 489 (SRS) and the Regional Sponsored Migration Scheme (RSMS) subclass 187 (Direct Entry). RDA Riverina's objectives in providing these visas are to:

- assist regional employers wishing to sponsor skilled migrants for skilled positions which cannot be filled using the local labour market.
- to assist skilled people who wish to come to the region. Applicants must nominate an
  occupation which is reflected on the <u>Skills in Demand List</u> the Riverina region. This list
  was updated on 18 April 2017.
