

City Centre to Lake Wyangan

Get ready to set out 12kms from the CBD to discover farm land and residential villages before reaching Lake Wyangan. Grab a packed lunch before you leave from one of our local eateries to enjoy a serene picnic by the water once you reach your destination.

City Centre to Village of Hanwood

Suitable for Walking & Cycling, Accessible

A 5km walking and biking track that connects Hanwood to the Griffith CBD. Look out for local grape vineyards, citrus orchards, and road side produce stands as you enter the village of Hanwood, home to Griffith's Gurdawara Sahib, the Sikh temple, which will stop you in vour tracks.

Scenic Hill Bush Walk

Suitable for Walking & Jogging

Immerse yourself in the beauty of natural bushland with the Scenic Hill trail. Walk or run through this bush land reserve, the chosen track for local running clubs and regular bush walkers. Bask in the serenity of Scenic Hill and enjoy the foliage of local natives along the way.

City Centre to Collina

Suitable for Walking & Cycling, Accessible

A popular route for local walkers, joggers and cyclists that links the city centre to the suburban area of Collina. Loop around Ted Scobie Oval and enjoy wonderful views of the McPherson Ranges on Scenic Hill.

Scenic Hill to Hermit's Cave

Suitable for Walking

Perched high on the ridge of Scenic Hill, part of the McPherson Ranges is Hermit's Cave. which offers a wonderful view across irrigated farm land to the Binya Hills. Experience a piece of culture and history as you head down to walk the trails of the hermit, exploring the cave that was once home to Valerio Ricetti. While in the area, make a pit stop into Pioneer Park Museum and be taken back to the early settlement of our region. Be sure to keep a look out for the native flora while on scenic drive.
